COVID-19 Quarantine, Return to Work, and Time Charging Requirements

Released October 1, 2021

Time Charging Guidance:

- Leave recorded for required COVID-19 related quarantines shall be in accordance with NAS policies and/or the Air Engineering Metal Trades Council Collective Bargaining Agreement as applicable.
 - o Salaried employees: use PTO, Accumulated Comp Time, or LWOP
 - Wage employees: use Vacation, Deferred Holiday, Sick Leave (if COVID-19 positive or symptomatic), or LWOP
 - o LWOP must be approved by the applicable Director in accordance with NAS Policy 00-0058, Leave Without Pay
 - April Powers may be contacted at <u>april.powers.ctr@us.af.mil</u> or (931) 454-5217 to initiate a Personal Leave of Absence (LOA). Personal LOAs may be granted for a 30-day period with approval by the General Manager on a case-by-case basis

Unvaccinated Team Members:

- Positive COVID-19 test (see Table 1)
 - o Quarantine Period: 10 calendar days after the date of the test
 - Returning to Work: After a period of 24 hours without a fever (without the use of fever reducing medications),
 and 10 calendar days after the date of the test, and after clearing through MedWorks

- COVID-19 symptoms (see Table 2)
 - o Quarantine Period: Up to 10 calendar days after the date symptoms first appeared
 - <u>Returning to work:</u> After receipt of a negative COVID-19 Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) test; or after being diagnosed with something other than COVID-19; or after 10 calendar days. Any of the conditions also require being cleared through MedWorks before returning

Vaccinated Team Members:

- Positive COVID-19 test (see Table 4)
 - o Quarantine Period: 10 calendar days after the date of the test
 - Returning to Work: After a period of 24 hours without a fever (without the use of fever reducing medications),
 and 10 calendar days after the date of the test, and after clearing through MedWorks

 - o Quarantine Period: Up to 10 calendar days after the date symptoms first appeared

- Close Contact with COVID-19 Positive Individual (see Table 6)
 - Quarantine Period: No quarantine required unless (1) an employee chooses not to take a COVID-19 PCR test within 3-5 calendar days from the date of close contactⁱⁱ; (2) the PCR test is positive; or (3) the employee develops symptoms
 - 1. If the employee chooses not to take a PCR test within 3-5 calendar days from the date of close contact, the employee shall quarantine until such time 14 calendar days have passed since the date of the close contactⁱⁱ
 - 2. If the employee's PCR test results are positive, go to 'Positive COVID-19 Test' scenario
 - 3. If the employee develops symptoms, go to 'COVID-19 Symptoms' scenario
 - Returning to Work: 14 calendar days after the date of close contact if the employee chooses not to take a PCR test within 3-5 calendar days from the date of close contact

- Continuous close contact with a COVID-19 Positive individual (e.g., a COVID-19 positive individual in the same house with whom the employee cannot avoid close contact) (see Table 7)
 - Quarantine Period: An employee who cannot avoid close contact with a person who is COVID-19 positive, should take a PCR test within 3-5 calendar days from the date of the initial close contactⁱⁱⁱ. They must then quarantine after 5 days from the initial close contact until such time a PCR test is taken 3 days after the date continuous close contact ceases^{iv}.
 - Returning to work: The day after the PCR test that is collected 3 days following the date continuous close contact ceases

¹ Symptomatic employees, regardless of vaccination status, may return to work if a negative PCR test is collected within 48 hours of base entry

if a vaccinated employee chooses not to take a PCR test within 3-5 days after close contact, they must quarantine for 14 days after the date of close contact

iii If a vaccinated employee is in continuous close contact with multiple COVID-19 positive persons, then testing and quarantine timelines are extended from the date of the last close contact

^{iv} If a vaccinated employee who has been in continuous close contact with a COVID-19 positive person chooses not to take a PCR test after 3 days from the date the continuous close contact ceases, they are required to quarantine for 14 days after that last close contact
